

## Who is Eligible

Participants must be enrolled in grades K - 5. Children who attend a school other than Piney Branch Elementary or Takoma Park Elementary are eligible to register; **however, transportation is the responsibility of the parent.**

Registration is accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. **Previous enrollment does not guarantee placement.**

## How to Enroll

You can register for the Morning and/or Afternoon Program's in person, or online at [www.takomaparkmd.gov/government/recreation](http://www.takomaparkmd.gov/government/recreation). A 20% deposit will be required at the time of registration.

Once you are registered and payment has been made, the following forms must be completed **BEFORE** your child can attend the program: Participant Information Form and/or Medical Authorization Form (if needed). Forms can be found online at [www.takomaparkmd.gov/government/recreation](http://www.takomaparkmd.gov/government/recreation) and are due prior to the child(ren)'s first day in the program.

**Parent orientation will be on Thursday, August 22, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. This will be your opportunity to meet the staff and learn more about the Morning & Afternoon Addition Programs.**

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## Morning Addition

Morning Addition fees are \$1,300 for residents and \$1,600 for non-residents per child, per year for the 10-month school year. There is a 20% deposit due at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be divided into eight (8) payments of **\$130** for residents and **\$160** for non-residents per child, per month beginning October 1.



## Afternoon Addition

Afternoon Addition fees are \$2,100 for residents and \$2,600 for non-residents per child, per year for the 10-month school year. There is a 20% deposit due at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be divided into eight (8) payments of **\$210** for residents and **\$260** for non-residents per child, per month beginning October 1.



## Morning & Afternoon Addition

Fees for both the Morning & Afternoon Addition programs are \$2,850 for residents and \$3,450 for non-residents per child, per year for the 10-month school year. There is a 20% deposit due at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be divided into eight (8) payments of **\$285** for residents and **\$345** for non-residents per child, per month beginning October 1.

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### Philosophy

The Morning & Afternoon Addition Programs are held at the **Takoma Park Community Center at 7500 Maple Avenue**. They are geared to provide high quality before and after school care at a reasonable cost. Our goal is to contribute to the social and emotional development of each child through a recreational focus in a safe, positive environment. Self-confidence, self-respect and self-expression are encouraged as is responsibility, decision making and respect for others. We offer a variety of activities, both structured and unstructured, on a daily basis to meet the needs of all program participants.

The Morning & Afternoon Addition Program is designed to provide before and after school recreational activities for children enrolled in Kindergarten through Fifth Grade. Through structured activities and free choice of activities, there are opportunities for socializing, unwinding, as well as time for doing homework. Activities may be arranged according to ages, interests, and geared toward varying skill levels.

### Transportation Plan

**Morning Addition:** Participants will be grouped and escorted to one of (2) two designated schools: Piney Branch or Takoma Park Elementary Schools.

**Afternoon Addition:**

**Takoma Park Elementary School:** Participants from TPES will be met by Afternoon Addition staff at designated locations and then escorted to the Community Center.

**Piney Branch Elementary School:** Participants from PBES will be met by Afternoon Addition staff in the hallway near the pool and then escorted to the Community Center.

**All Other Schools:** Parents must arrange their own transportation to the program. *Morning & Afternoon Addition staff will assume responsibility for the child after they have arrived to the program.*

### Early Dismissals & Weather Related Closures

The Afternoon Addition Program will be open from the time school closes until 6:30 p.m. on designated Montgomery County Public School half days. In the event that schools close early for weather related incidents, parents will have 1-hour to pick-up their child(ren) from the program.

### School Closings & Holidays

On holidays when schools are closed, the Morning & Afternoon Addition program will also be closed. This schedule will be available to parents prior to the first day of the program. The Recreation Department offers Winter and Spring Break Camps, as well as a Fun Day program for an additional fee.
