T-Ball Sports Code of Conduct

Players are expected to:

- · Come to practices and games with a good attitude and ready to play with the required equipment.
- · Put the well-being of the team ahead of their own personal desire to win.
- · Take direction from their coach, officials, and other league staff.
- · Act respectfully towards others before, during, and after practices or games.
- · Only use the Recreation Department's property and equipment as intended and with respect.

Parents & spectators are expected to:

- · Be a role model for all players by demonstrating the positive support of everyone.
- · Put the well-being of the participants ahead of my own personal desire to win.
- · Support the decisions of the coach, officials, and staff.
- · Act respectfully towards others before, during, and after practices or games.
- · Insist that youth play in a safe and healthy environment and notify the Recreation Department if this is not the case.

Infractions of the Code of Conduct may include, but are not limited to the following:

- · Unsportsmanlike conduct
- · Offensive or negative language
- · Disrespectful behavior
- · Fighting or deliberate roughness
- · Repeated delay of game or practice
- · Not shaking hands after a game/leaving in the middle of the game without team's permission
- · Taking off jersey/t-shirt during game
- · Damage to school/park/facility property
